

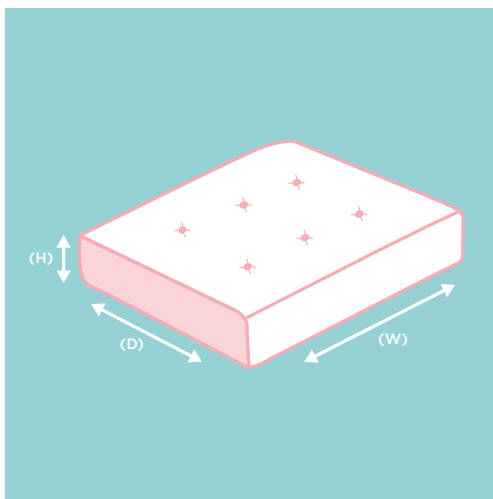
WILL IT FIT?

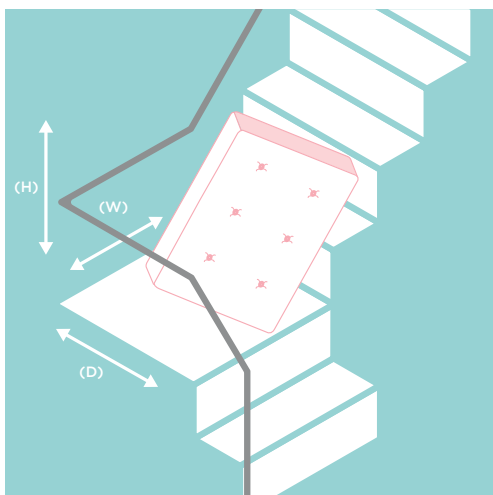

MEASURING UP YOUR MATTRESS

First, scribble down the dimensions of your mattress in the boxes below. You can find all mattress dimensions at loaf.com. You'll need to refer to these as you take the various measurements around your home.

LANDING AND STAIRS

Measure the width of your stairs at their narrowest point (don't forget to account for handrails and light fixtures).

If there's a landing then measure the width, depth and height of your landing.

If you have a bannister and need to lift it over, check that the distance between the bannister and the ceiling is greater than the height of the mattress at the narrowest height.
