

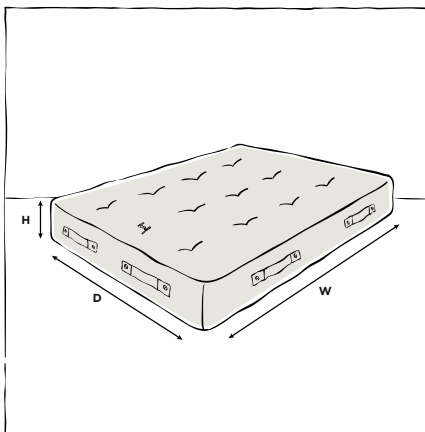
Make sure it fits

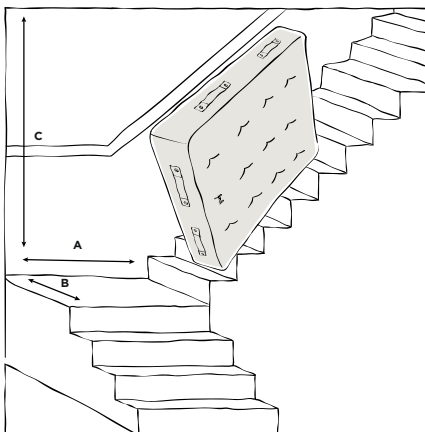
Measuring up your mattress

First, scribble down the dimensions of your mattress in the boxes below. You can find dimensions for all of our mattresses on our website (loaf.com, if you didn't already know). You'll need to refer to these as you take the various measurements around your home, so keep them handy.

Landing

Measure the width of your stairs at their narrowest point, not forgetting to account for handrails and light fixtures.

If there's a landing, then measure the width, depth and height of your landing. As long as these measurements are all larger than the dimensions of your mattress, you should be a-okay.

If you have a bannister and need to lift it over, check that the distance between the bannister and the ceiling is greater than the height of the mattress at the narrowest height.
